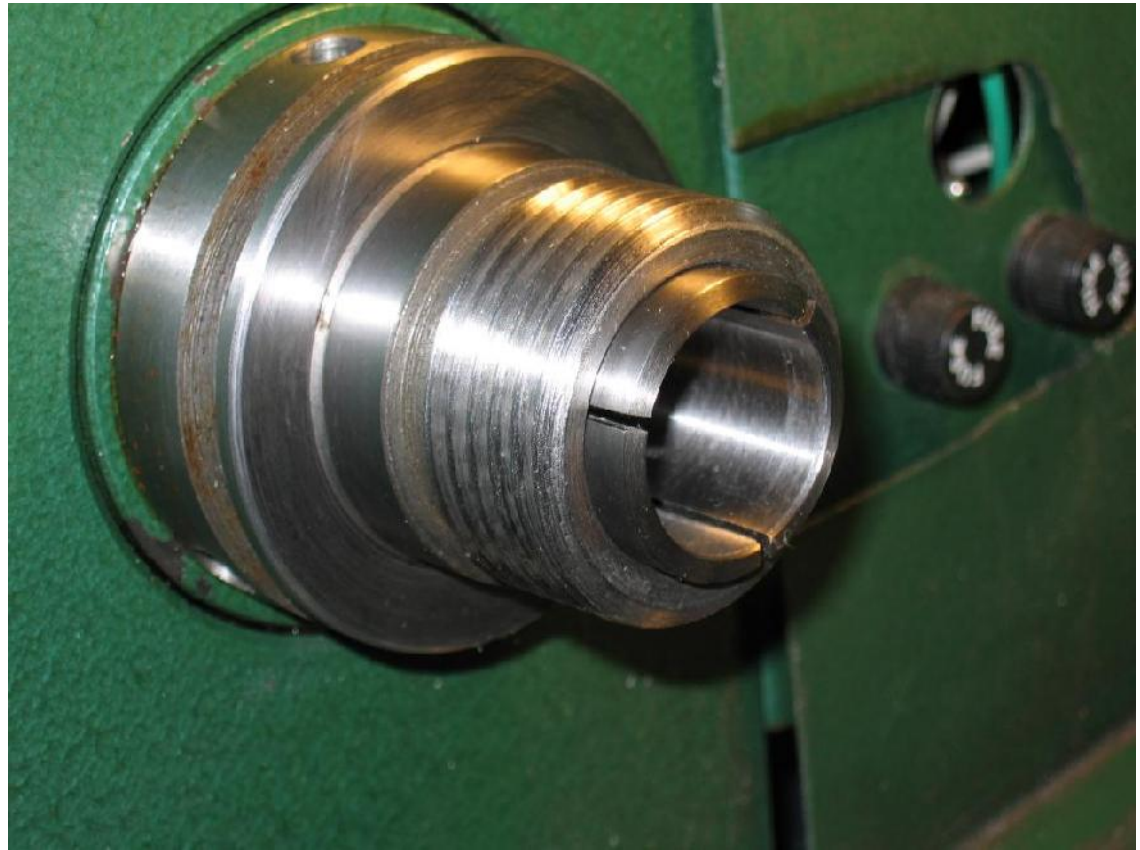

It may depend on how active your account is, how many actual site hits vs picture loads occur, etc.

they make money from the site hits, not from picture loads.

If they wanted to get rid of that, presumably all they would have to do is eliminate the option of creating a direct photo load, which is the bottom option on the typical list.

The next one up is an HTML, then the link, and the top is a link for email usage. If they just eliminated those options, they would automatically get the site traffic from links, as that is what you would have to do.
